Route follows a pretty stretch of the Thames path then a lovely section of the Chiltern Way . We pass through Crowsley Park before skirting Binfield Heath and returning to the start. Largely flat with a few hills in the second half. Bring food and drink for the day. Wednesday 02 Sep 10:15 am	The Oakley Green Circuit Leader(s): Simon C. 07930 378837 Class: Leisurely; Distance: 3.7 miles Once we have escaped from urban Dedworth we enter some countryside near Oakley Green and Fifield. After ten minutes or so of pavement walking the route enters a series of fields. Having skimmed Fifield we end up on some secluded footpaths and more fields. Horses and deer have been seen in this section. We return to the road and retrace our steps back to Tinkers Lane. Free parking in Tinkers lane near the council site. Wednesday 09 Sep 10:00 am	Ancient woodland and open fields from Naphill Leader(s): Dawn D. 07793 232963 Class: Moderate; Distance: 7.5 miles; Total Ascent: 862 feet Our walk, typified by woods and open fields, starts in Naphill then descends through woods to the charming village of Bradenham. Passing through open fields, we then ascend into Park Wood, ancient beech woodland which supplied the High Wycombe furniture industry. More open fields take us to Lacey Green, Speen then Upper North Dean before climbing back through the woods to Naphill. This is a hilly walk with a few stiles and some far-reaching views of the Hughenden Valley. We will stop for our traditional 'banana break' after approx 4 miles - please bring a snack and drink. We will have a table booked for lunch at The Wheel in Naphill. Orders will be taken by the leader before setting off. Assistance dogs only please. We will cross over the A328 and after a little road walking pass into the Great Park at Bishopsgate. We will have our break at the Copper Horse, and then make our way back to the car park via the Savill gardens (where there are very superior toilets) The walk is not muddy, there is an amount of road walking in the Great Park as well as outside it.
